

**Summer Racing Series 2010**  
**Ensign Fleet 76**

**1. ELIGIBILITY:**

- 1.1. The helmsman of each competing yacht shall be considered the contestant.
- 1.2. If a question of eligibility arises, Part III, Rule 6 of the Ensign Class National Championship Rules shall govern.

**2. BOATS AND SAILS :**

- 2.1. All boats and sails must conform to Part II of the Ensign Class Association Rules.

**3. RACES AND RULES :**

- 3.1. One throw out will be allowed if at least eight races are completed, Two throw outs if ten races are completed.
- 3.2. Five completed race will constitute a series.
- 3.3. The series will be sailed under the 2009-12 US Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing and the Ensign Class Association Rules.

**4. SCORING :**

- 4.1. The Low-Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will be used.

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS :**

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be made available to all competitors through the fleet secretary before the first race.

**6. ENTRY and FEES:**

- 6.1. Registration is required. Registration before June 12<sup>th</sup> is encouraged and appreciated. Registration before June 6<sup>th</sup> is required.
- 6.2 Fee for the series is \$55.

**7. PRIZES :**

- 7.1. The top three finishing competitors will receive trophies at the MYC Annual Meeting.
