

2024 Wednesday Night PHRF Series NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The Wednesday Night Series will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing), and by MYC Wednesday Night Series Sailing Instructions. Where conflicts occur among the rules, the Wednesday Night Sailing Instructions shall take precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

The series is open to boats with a current valid 2024 PHRF-NE certificate or boats with a Portsmouth Rating. Eligible boats may be entered by filing a completed Wednesday Night Race Entry Form with its accompanying fee and, except for Portsmouth Handicap, a copy of the yacht's current PHRF-NE rating certificate with the Race Committee no later than the Tuesday before the start of the series (Please note that a boat receiving it's PHRF-NE certificate through MYC will already have it on file.)

Entries received after that date may be charged a late fee. In any case, a boat will not be scored for an individual race unless the required forms and fee have been received at least 24 hours before the start of the race.

3. FEES

4. DATES of RACING

- June Series- June 5th, June 12th, June 19th, June 31st.
- July Series- July 10th, July 17th, July 24th, Jul 31st.
- August Series- Aug 7th, Aug 14th, Aug 21rd, Aug 28th.

5. MEASUREMENTS

Each PHRF boat shall produce a valid 2024 certificate. Portsmouth Number Rated boats will use the current Portsmouth Number Rating.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available online.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

Taking a One or Two- Turn Penalty in compliance with 44.1 & 44.2 Taking a scoring penalty in compliance with RRS 44.3. The penalty shall not be less than 2 places.

8. SCORING

- Month series
 - a) Will be scored using the Low Point System (RRS A4)
 - b) When 3 or less races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her race scored
 - c) When 4 or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her races scored excluding her worst score.
- The Summer Series
 - a) Will be the total of all races in June, July, and August series.
 - b) When 8 or less races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her races scored.
 - c) When 9 races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her races scored excluding her worst race.
 - d) When 10 or more races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her races scored excluding her two worst races.
